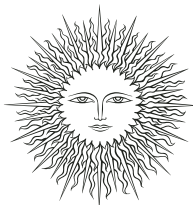

Please note:

We expect these figures to apply to all payments made during one year starting February 2008, subject to any unforeseen circumstances; fees charged will otherwise be at the rates applicable at the time of payment. An inflationary adjustment or fee increase for course improvements may be made in subsequent years and at least 30 days advance notice of such increases will be given. Seminar, Workshop and Supervision guidance fees are given for the current year only and do not include room and board or transportation if needed — fees in subsequent years may be higher.

In addition to these fees, you should allow approximately \$225 for textbooks in Year 1, \$400-\$500 for Year 2 onwards. We also encourage Student Membership of the North American Society of Homeopaths.

Higher annual rates apply if fees are paid at instalment rates. Please bear in mind that fee rates for Years 2-4 are provided for guidance only, being subject to annual review.

ENROLMENT AND RE-ENROLMENT

Your fee for each Year of the homeopathy correspondence course covers your study for up to 2 years from the time of payment or up to 8 months for each installment payment. Your fee for the Anatomy & Physiology or Pathology & Disease covers your study for up to 2 years from the time of payment for those courses. If you have nearly finished your study on any of these courses at that time, however, we are usually a little flexible!

To extend your study time by a further period of up to 12 months, we will ask you for a re-enrolment fee for each applicable course to cover the extra costs that we incur as a result of your delayed study. Repeated payment of this fee can be made to extend your study time year by year. The re-enrolment fee rate in 2008 is \$190 for the homeopathy course and \$80 for the Anatomy & Physiology or Pathology & Disease courses, but there may be an additional charge if any study material needs replacing because of important updates to the course.

If you have paid for a whole Year in advance, then subsequent study units will be sent to you automatically as you progress through the Course. If you are paying by instalments, please remember that future units will only be sent if the next appropriate payment has been received.

All fee payments must be up-to-date before progress onto the next Year of the course can commence.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

We offer a full refund on all courses as long as your enrolment with us is cancelled within seven days from the date you were enrolled on the course. Registration fees are non-refundable. Please let us know by the quickest means and then in writing with an explanation of why you are not satisfied with the course. All course material must be returned in 'as new' condition within fourteen days; a deduction will be made if the returned material is damaged.

Beyond this seven-day period, if you wish to withdraw from any course for good reason, subsequent to registration, a refund may be granted subject to the following points: Course Registration Fees are non-refundable. All refunds are subject to: post & packing fees, bank charge reconciliation and a 10% administration charge. No refunds are given on study material received after the seven-day period. Study material is not accepted for return. No refund of the homeopathy course fees will be given if more than six months have elapsed since the student was enrolled on the course (three months for medical science courses). Refunds may be given for Homeopathy Units paid for and not yet dispatched, providing that a study cancellation request is made within six months of purchase. For medical science courses, if you purchased the course with tutor marking, are still inside the three-month period and have not sent work in to your tutor then a partial refund for the tutor marking element of the course may be given. If you are paying by instalments, no refund will be given, as you have only paid for the associated units as you need them. All and any refunds will be related to fees applying at the time of registration.
