

**CLINICAL EDUCATION** A key element in the study and practice of homeopathy is the adventure of observing and working directly with experienced homeopaths, viewing and analyzing cases, meeting with colleagues, and putting theories and assumptions to the test.

The School of Homeopathy, Devon, England's 2006 North American Clinical Program offers the opportunity to develop your understanding and scope through participation in Seminars and Clinical Workshops provided by senior UK faculty. These sessions afford practical experience and information for those who wish to enhance their skills of case analysis and management, and to enrich their knowledge of remedies, old and new.

**THE SEMINARS** These three-day sessions are open to all students and practitioners. We also provide the option for members of the homeopathic community outside the school to attend for two days only if they wish. Through lectures, video cases and discussion, they provide new insights into understanding and analyzing the case, and applying new methods for differentiating remedies. This often includes fascinating new proving information.

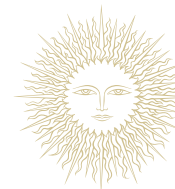
The presentations are structured so that newer students are quickly brought along and their horizons widened. Advanced students and practitioners benefit from new perspective on cases, subtle aspects of remedies, and fresh methods and philosophy presented.

**A STUDENT EVENING** held before each seminar is reserved for students and graduates of the School. This provides an opportunity to meet together in an informal atmosphere, to discuss issues related to course studies, and to plan social activities around the seminar. This is a time for sharing, so you are invited to bring your questions, suggestions, and ideas.

**CLINICAL WORKSHOPS** For advanced students and practitioners only, these week-long residential sessions provide an intensive experience in case work and management. The clinical workshops are open to anyone with at least two years of study or practice experience, including students of the School at Unit 11 or further.

The prime objective of these workshops is to help participants develop their case-work skills, leading to more effective practice. A wide range of teaching cases on video, as well as live cases where practical, are presented. The sessions are designed as interactive, process-orientated learning experiences, leading not only to a much deeper understanding of homeopathy, but also sharpening self awareness and skills in self-evaluation. Lectures, discussion, and small and large group exercises are facilitated by leading UK homeopaths with an expert level of knowledge in many up-to-date modes of practice.

A **CLINICAL CERTIFICATE** is available from the School, but students and practitioners not seeking this certification are equally welcome to attend. This certificate requires attendance at two workshops and one seminar, with rigorous assessment assignments set at each workshop, plus completion of appropriate study in orthodox medicine. It is part of the School's requirement for its PDHom (UK) Practitioner Diploma, which also requires students to have a thorough understanding of advanced homeopathic theory and practice, of anatomy, physiology, pathology and disease, and to have comprehensive supervision of their early practice cases.

Much education is content driven because we like to come away with the material that we have been taught. However, the facts, though useful in themselves, are rarely more than hooks upon which to hang our processes of understanding: the perceptions, intuitions and insights into understanding which we may later transform into wisdom. In these case-based seminars, Janet continues to explore the concepts of sensation, kingdom and miasm as developed by Rajan Sankaran. With beautiful cured cases as the reference points, Janet guides us to discover what's at the heart of a case, and to understand how to reach the deeper levels of sensation and energy that reveal the inner state of the patient and the remedy needed. Her generosity, humor, practical experience and thoughtful choice of cases all combine to make her teaching some of the best that can be found. The Boulder session is open to students at all levels, while the Ithaca seminar, coming at the end of the clinical workshop, is reserved for advanced students.

These workshops provide you with many pointers on the compass of understanding disease and helping you develop homeopathic skills in clinical practice. The main topic is the patient, live and on video and the analysis. The endeavor is centered around understanding the primary, uncompensated, state and its secondary expressions which may then be translated into rubrics and repertorized. We also 'take the case' of many remedies, seeing the common processes involved with case analysis to more readily find the similimum.

THE WEEK-LONG SESSION IN DEVON will consist of 6 days of teaching, and a 'rest' day with optional outing possibilities. Delicious lunches are prepared at the School each teaching day.

MISHA LEADS OFF THE ITHACA WORKSHOP with 3 intensive interactive days, in which participants in process-orientated learning experiences develop their case-work skills, deepen homeopathic understanding and sharpen self awareness.

JANET FOLLOWS AT ITHACA with 3 seminar-style days, which are also open to other advanced students (see opposite). The full week takes place at a beautiful residential retreat outside of Ithaca.

TOPICS PRESENTED AT BOTH SESSIONS through cases and in small group sessions typically include: case receiving; perceiving what needs to be cured; recognizing characteristic expressions of the miasms and kingdoms; repertorizing central themes; potency; evaluation of response; second and subsequent prescriptions. Other topics such as supervision, practice issues, computers, family dynamics, etc., depend on the needs of the group. During Misha's sessions, small group work engenders an atmosphere where voluntary case-giving may be an option. (It is required that such volunteers do have a current prescriber overseeing their case.)
